

Mizoram govt extends grace period for occupants of selected quarters scheduled for demolition

AIZAWL, AUG 19 --/ The GAD, Mizoram government on Friday issued order extending timeline of allotment to the occupants of selected government quarters at Ainawn Veng.

The order states: In continuation to, and in partial modification of this department's 'notice', issued vide No. D. 11014/1/2022-GAD (GM), dated June 22, the competent authority hereby extends the timeline scheduled to allottees of government buildings/quarters at Ainawn Veng to vacate their respective quarters up to December 31, 2023. This extension of timeline has been considered and given on the basis of the prayers received from the allottees as well as from the Joint NGO, and also taking into account the practical

requirement of carrying out the demolition process in phases.

However, the allottees/occupants of government buildings/quarters at Ainawn Veng are hereby advised to vacate their respective quarters at the

earliest without waiting for the expiry of the extended deadline for their own safety. The extended period shall not include the occupants of the buildings/quarters, which have been listed to be dismantled in the first phase. (DIPR)

Eviction notice

AIZAWL, AUG 19 --/ The Mizoram government served final eviction notice to the occupants of government's quarter which are verified to be unsafe for occupying through the GAD's order dated 18th August 2023.

The order states: In pursuance of the decision of the meeting of the Council of Ministers dated May 18, 2023 and on the recommendation of the joint inspection team on government buildings/quarters at Ainawn Veng, the following Government buildings/quarters are hereby ordered to be dismantled in the first phase on priority basis due to the extreme deteriorated structural conditions and for the safety of the residents and surrounding areas.

The occupants of the above buildings/quarters shall vacate without further delay. Upon completion of the first phase, the dismantling process of the remaining Government buildings/quarters at Ainawn Veng shall be continued accordingly. (DIPR)

ICAR Director calls on Meghalaya Guv

Govt aiming to raise capacity of ports four-fold to 10,000 MTPA by 2047: Union minister Sonowal

KEVADIA, AUG 19 --/ The Union government has set itself a target of raising the country's port capacity to more than 10,000 Metric Ton Per Annum by 2047 from the current 2,600 MTPA, Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways Sarbananda Sonowal said here on Saturday.

The government will soon set up a Bureau of Port Security to upgrade security across all ports in the country, he said at the 19th Maritime States Development Council meeting at Kevadia in Gujarat's Narmada district near the Statue of Unity.

"The country's total port capacity will increase from existing around 2,600 MTPA to more than 10,000 MTPA in 2047," a government release quoted him as saying. Sonowal said the country's maritime sector is poised for substantial growth with over Rs 10 lakh crore worth of investment opportunities identified, with the opportunity to generate employment for over 15 lakh youths.

"In alignment with this vision, the role of private

players is being progressively augmented, with public-private partnership (PPP) terminals currently handling about 50 per cent of the cargo at major ports and efforts underway to raise their share to approximately 85 per cent in the coming decades," the Union minister said.

The government is working with a focus to enhance cargo movement on India's national waterways, which witnessed a 16 per cent year-on-year increase in the last fiscal year, he said. "Ambitious targets have been set to achieve a substantial quantum of 500 MTPA by 2047, underlining the government's commitment to leveraging the maritime sector as a catalyst for comprehensive national growth," stated the release, quoting the Union minister Sonowal also shared the ministry's ambitious plan to develop "hydrogen hubs" across the ports run by the Centre and state governments. "All the Central and state

government ports will explore the possibility of creating hydrogen hubs," he said, adding that the Deendayal Port Authority in Gujarat has already finalised MoUs worth Rs 1.68 lakh crore for this venture.

The two-day 19th Maritime State Development Council meeting organised by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW) to enhance better coordination between major and notified ports, state maritime boards, state governments and Union Territories concluded on Saturday. (PTI)

G20: Mandaviya launches initiative aimed at aligning efforts to support global strategy on digital health

GANDHINAGAR, AUG 19 --/ Union Minister Mansukh Mandaviya on Saturday launched the 'Global Initiative on Digital Health - a WHO Managed Network' at Mahatma Mandir convention centre here on the second and last day of G20 health ministers' meeting. It was launched by the Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare in the presence of World Health Organisation Director General Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus. The initiative will consolidate the evidence and amplify recent and past gains in global digital health for health systems while strengthening mutual accountability to enhance the impact of future investments, a PIB release said. According to Mandaviya, fragmented digital solutions being used currently were resulting in significant workload on health workers, inefficiencies due to duplication and lack of interoperability.

"India's G20 presidency has leveraged its experience on developing a national digital health architecture through the convergence of digital health interventions aimed at health systems strengthening through interoperability by design," the PIB release said quoting the Union minister.

On the occasion, Mandaviya thanked G20 and invited countries, international organisations and other stakeholders for collectively recognizing the need for a common framework and creating a comprehensive digital health ecosystem through the 'Global Initiative on

Digital Health a WHO Managed Network'. Mandaviya also reminded the dignitaries that India led the Digital Health resolution at the 71st World Health Assembly in 2018 in Geneva, which spurred global action on this vital agenda.

Speaking at the event, Ghebreyesus said the GIDH is an integrative step that fosters equity in healthcare by converging efforts and best practices. "It will amplify our efforts with the incorporation of tools, such as AI while giving due importance to ethics, policy, and governance.

GIDH will ensure that no one is left behind," the WHO DG said. He said WHO is committed to use the latest technologies for health, adding that the power of digital health technologies like telemedicine and AI has had a significant impact across the world over the last two decades. The potential and successful implementation of technology during the times of severe healthcare disruptions was evident during Covid-19 in the form of telemedicine usage, Ghebreyesus said. The GIDH will be a WHO Managed Network ('Network of Networks') that will promote equitable
